What will we explore, learn & practice?

Together we will discover how we can consciously create and host spaces for collaborative conversations that generate wise action in our organisations, communities and families. This training is experiential - you will have opportunities to practise "hosting" various participatory processes and methodologies. The training will support you to host more effective, purposeful meetings, and host groups in complex systems working together to solve their own challenges.

The learning includes:

- Simple and powerful social tools such as Circle, World Café, Appreciative Inquiry, Open Space Technology, Designing for Wiser Action, storytelling and more
- Complementary models and frameworks including complexity theory and practice, and new organisational forms
- Conscious presence and leadership, and working with emergence
- Real world application.
