The Art of Hosting offers the awareness and mental models to see the world and our work in the world in new ways that fully embrace the uncertainty and acknowledge the inherent complexity of living systems as an asset to change and evolve as human beings.

The Art of Hosting offers individual and collective practices to uplevel our leadership and co-create new ways of organising towards sustainable and regenerative futures.

The Art of Hosting offers simple yet powerful tools and methods to leverage collaboration and activate the collective intelligence of any group.

The Art of Hosting training is experiential and hands-on. We **exchange** knowledge, **experience** participatory methods, **explore** mental models and theories. We dive into new forms of leadership, where interconnection and self-organising around purpose lead to results for collective wellbeing. We support participants to integrate the methods through action learning.





PURPOSE OF THE TRAINING The Intention with this AoH training is to gather individuals from Europe and beyond who are ready to find their learning edge and grow their capacity for leading and collaborating in times of uncertainty.

The purpose of the training is to:

- Build individual and organizational capacity for participatory leadership across all levels of society.
- Explore, learn and practice collaborative ways of responding to complex systemic challenges in our communities through engaging in conversations that matter.
- Foster a community of practice to support the creation of more spaces where meaningful dialogue can lead to wise action where it is most needed

WHO IS IT FOR?

Whether you come from the private, public, third or NGO sectors or are simply an engaged citizen, this cross-sectoral training is a vibrant learning space where your thinking can expand, your projects can be refined and you can build lasting relationships that can support the impact of your work long into the future.

- The Art of Harvesting how to visually capture and make sense of meetings and conversations for clarity, learning, growth and wise action.
- Apply what you are learning directly to the change projects that are important to you, your community or organisation
